NESAY (North East Support and Action for Youth) will be presenting a free community information session about family violence and young people in the Ovens Murray region at 8am on October 26 at Gateway Health Wangaratta.

NESAY works to support and act for young people in the community and has provided youth and family welfare services since the 1970s to address issues of adolescence, family life and youth homelessness.

NESAY's practice principles are to promote social change, problem solving in relationships and empowerment to enhance individual wellbeing.

Its programs work within local communities, schools, families and with individual young people, who may be at risk of school disengagement, family breakdown, at risk of entering child protection system, family violence and be homeless or at risk of homelessness.

This session is suitable for community members who wish to learn more about the services available in Ovens Murray for those experiencing or at risk of experiencing family violence.
